Such deposits will be returned within thirty (30) days to all unsuccessful bidders. The Bid Security of each successful bidder shall be retained by the City of Revere, Massachusetts, until such time as full executed contracts have been submitted

The City of Revere as the awarding authority, may accept any bid or portion of a bid, waive any informality in a bid, order more or less of any item, investigate the ability of the vendors to honor a bid, select a vendor who does not submit the lowest bid and award all contracts as shall be considered in the best interest of the City of Revere.

It is the policy of the City of Revere to take positive steps to maximize the utilization of minority business enterprises in all activities administered by this agency.

No bidder may withdraw his/her bid within forty-five (45) business days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
